We learned yesterday that, when Kirklees Cabinet meets on 20 February, they will be asked to approve a report with proposals to consult on making significant changes to the way Kirklees Library Service is to be delivered in future.

We have been told we will hear more, 'promptly' after the meeting, about the consultation process that will follow if the proposals are approved.

These proposals include one to move Denby Dale from being a 'community supported' library to being a 'community managed' library.
