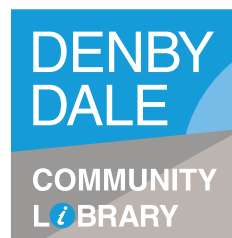


## Information from Trustees 25 July 2020



Kirklees Libraries has begun a phased recovery of services as coronavirus lockdown restrictions are lifted:

### You can return borrowed books

From 28 July you can return borrowed books to Denby Dale Community Library on Tuesdays 10am-1pm and Fridays 1pm-4pm.

✔ Please:

- Leave your books in the green bin outside the library between the above times
- Maintain a 2m distance if you are queuing to return your books

✘ Please don't:

- Put anything other than returned library books in the bin
- Take any books out of the bin.

Returned books will be quarantined for 72 hours before being replaced on library shelves. Also remember, there are no fines for late returns so you can return as many books as you need to!

### You can also 'Ring and Read'

By phoning Kirklees Libraries you can tell them what types of books you like to read and which library you want to collect them from. They will select books for you from that library's stock. You collect them the following week at your appointment time.

From 28 July you can phone 01484 414868 to order a selection of books from Denby Dale Community Library or one of the other open libraries.

From 4 August you can collect your books from Denby Dale Community Library, with appointment time slots available on Tuesdays 10am-1pm and Fridays 1pm-4pm.
